



THE OLYMPICS

Take a look at some of the exciting things we are going to be doing and learning!

Personal, Social, Emotional <u>Development</u>

We are going to be celebrating the things we are good at as well as discussing and practising the things we would like to improve upon such as trying different sports activities.

We are going to support and help our friends to take part in games and sport activities, showing how we take turns, share and work together. We are going to be taking it in turns to play different sport game and activities and creating and writing our own rules and boundaries for the games we are playing, sharing and explaining them to our friends.

Physical Development

We are going to be observing and describing the effects physical activity has on our bodies. We are going to be learning about the importance of healthy choices and how to help keep ourselves fit and healthy.

We are going to be developing spatial awareness skills through playing running games, completing obstacle courses and talking about how to safely use the space we have around us.

We are going to be taking part in games that involve throwing, catching, rolling and kicking to help develop strength, balance and coordination in our limbs.

Communication and Language

We are going to be extending our understanding of 'who', 'what', 'where', 'why', and 'how' by identifying actions and objects in pictures, in the environment and through our play.

We are going to develop an understanding of simple concepts and prepositions when completing obstacle courses and treasure hunts as well as in our play.

Through activities and games we are going to further develop our listening and attention skills, carry out instructions with two – four key words to follow. For example 'can you place the small ball in the big bucket?'

Mathematics

We are going to be using spatial and positional language as we move around toys and objects and exploring fitting in to space to successfully complete games and activities.

We are going use numbers and numerals in our play, such as making hop-scotches, targets for bean bags, first, second and third place etc. We are going to be handling and exploring shapes to create Olympic stadiums, rowing boats, Olympic torches etc. We are going to be using common shape language such as circle, cube, square etc, and informal language such as slanty, pointy, bumpy.
